Press Release- Fatal Crash

August 4, 2021

On Tuesday, August 3, 2021 at 2:39pm the Door County Sheriff's Office was notified of a two-vehicle crash on CTH A at the intersection of CTH EE in the town of Gibraltar. Emergency responders from the Door County Emergency Services, Gibraltar Fire Department, Gibraltar First Responders, Door County Highway Department, Baileys Harbor Constable and the Door County Sheriff's Office responded to the scene.

The initial investigation indicated that a 2017 Ford Escape was traveling westbound on CTH EE. The Ford Escape was being driven by 81 year-old Florence McMillian of Chicago. The Ford failed to yield the right of way and entered the intersection where it was struck by a 1991 Mack dump truck that was traveling northbound on CTH A. The Mack dump truck was being driven by 51 year-old Curtis Rice of Sister Bay. McMillian was pronounced deceased at the scene.

CTH A and CTH EE in this area were closed for several hours while the crash was investigated. The Door County Sheriff's Office was assisted in the investigation by motor carrier inspectors and a crash reconstruction team from the Wisconsin State Patrol. CTH A and CTH EE were reopened for travel shortly before 9:00pm.

An autopsy is being performed today by the Dane County Medical Examiner's Office. This crash remains under investigation and no further information is being released at this time.
