COVID-19 Recurring Community Testing Sites for Door County

STURGEON BAY, WI – Door County is partnering with the Wisconsin National Guard to offer free COVID-19 testing for the community on a weekly recurring basis beginning on January 4th and going through March 8th. Testing will occur every Monday during that span from 8:00AM – 4:00PM.

The location of the testing site will rotate each week between a northern and a central site within the County to allow for as much of the County to have access to testing as possible.

The northern site will be located at the Sister Bay Fire Station 2258 Mill Road Sister Bay. The central site will be located at the Door County EMS facility 916 N 14th Ave Sturgeon Bay.

The dates of the northern site are as follows: January 4th, February 1st, March 1st (<u>NOTE: Notesting will be available on January 18th or February 15th due to national holidays)</u>

The dates of the central site are as follows: Januray 11th, 25th, February 8th, 22nd, March 8th

The public is encouraged to visit https://register.covidconnect.wi.gov to pre-register, but are not required to do so.

To be tested you must be experiencing at least a mild case of one of the following COVID-19 symptoms and be at least 5 years of age or older:

Cough	Fatigue	Sudden Loss of Taste/Smell
Shortness of Breath	Sore Throat	Congestion or runny nose
Fever	Muscle Pain	Nausea or vomiting
Chills	Headache	Diarrhea

This is a drive-thru testing site and anyone getting tested must stay in their vehicle. A nasal swab will be used to collect a sample by a uniformed member of the Wisconsin National Guard. Testing will be done on a first come first serve basis and will not be operating outside of the scheduled times.
